Scripture Readings to reflect on are Isaiah 40:25-31 and Revelation 6:9-11

Those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. — Isaiah 40:31

U13 Div 2 White - Runners Up


This team has had a hard year but are resilient and have improved so much. The girls went down fighting with a score 23 to 8 against Rovers Darts.
