This Week's Devotion

Too Busy To Pray?

If you were in space you could be right next to someone shouting and you would not hear. That's because voices travel as soundwaves and soundwaves need something like atmosphere to travel on. Since there is no atmosphere in space, sound waves have nothing to travel on.

God doesn't need sound waves or even radio waves to hear us. Our prayers carry our voices straight to God without any form of waves. If God is ready to listen to whatever we have to say – **why don't we pray more?**

Being busy, texting, playing video games, watching TV shows and computer work may distract us from praying. In our business, God calls us to be still (Psalm 46:10) and pray to Him.

Try it today. Find a special place where you can be alone with God. Follow Jesus example – 'After sending the people away, he went up a hill by himself to pray' Matthew 5: 44. 'When you pray, go to your room, close the door and pray to your Father who is unseen. And your Father who sees what you do in private will reward you.' Matthew 6: 6.

Be still, talk to God, praise and thank him and listen for Him to answer. Remember, God usually speaks with a still, small voice – so be sure to listen closely!

Check out some of the ways Jesus prayed in Luke 5:16: 6:12: and Matthew 14:23.

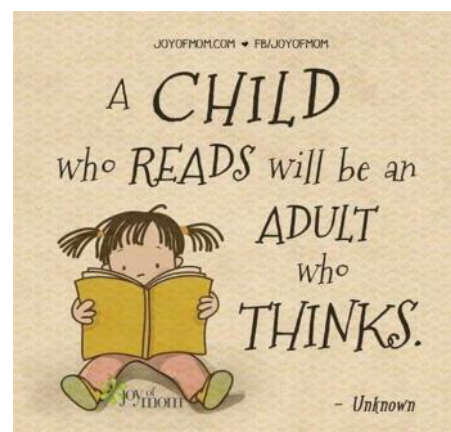
