During this week there have been a couple of reports of strangers approaching primary school students in the Larapinta area. Can parents please discuss with their children the

5 Rs:

1. **Recognise the danger** who what where is an exit
2. **Refuse the offer** do not go to the vehicle or get in a car with a person you do not know
3. **Raise the alarm** yell, shout make a noise
4. **Run** get out of there
5. **Report** make sure you tell a parent, guardian, teacher or police.

The teachers have addressed this with the children today, can parents please reinforce this over the weekend and from time to time. Remember not to alarm the child when discussing what to do if a stranger approaches them. Make sure that they understand the 5Rs.

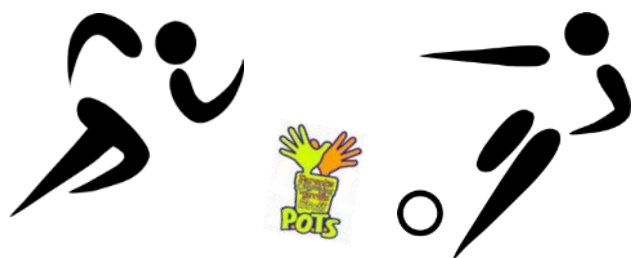
